BURBANK-GLENDALE-PASADENA AIRPORT AUTHORITY RESTARTS REPLACEMENT PASSENGER TERMINAL PROGRAM

BURBANK, Calif., August 23, 2021 — The Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority Commission voted today to restart work on a Program Definition Manual and Design Builder procurement documents for the Replacement Passenger Terminal (RPT) Program, which was placed on hold in March of 2020 at the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic.

The RPT Program is a safety enhancement project consisting of four major components:

- 14-Gate, 355,000 sq. ft. replacement terminal
- Airside improvements (terminal apron, taxiway extensions)
- Landside improvements (new access roadway, utilities, support facilities, parking structure)
- Demolition of the existing terminal and short-term parking structure

In 2016, Burbank voters approved Measure B, giving the Airport Authority the right to proceed with the RPT Program.
