## Hollywood Burbank Airport Releases January 2025 Passenger Statistics

BURBANK, Calif., February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2025 — January 2025 passenger numbers finished lower than 2024 levels.

January 2024	January 2025	Percentage difference
437,121 passengers	409,153 passengers	-6.4%

This follows a 9.9% increase in December 2024, compared to December 2023. 2024 was a record-breaking year for the airport, with more than 6.5 million passengers.

Commercial airline operations increased 2.5%, and general aviation operations increased 48% from January 2024 levels. Total air cargo increased 4%.

The top three airlines in January 2025 based on passenger count were: Southwest Airlines (210,189); Alaska Airlines (59,458); and United Airlines (40,725).
