## Hollywood Burbank Airport Releases February 2025 Passenger Statistics

BURBANK, Calif., March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025 — February 2025 passenger numbers finished higher than 2024 levels.

February 2024	February 2025	Percentage difference
417,214 passengers	425,370 passengers	+1.95%

This follows a 6.4% decrease in January 2025, compared to January 2024. 2024 was a record-breaking year for the airport, with more than 6.5 million passengers.

Commercial airline operations increased 6.5%, and general aviation operations increased 156% from February 2024 levels. Total air cargo decreased 8.6%.

The top three airlines in February 2025 based on passenger count were: Southwest Airlines (234,497); Alaska Airlines (57,732); and United Airlines (45,641).
