

Director of Engineering

Position Background:

TBI Airport Management, Inc. ("TBI") at Hollywood Burbank Airport ("Airport") has an immediate need for a Director of Engineering. The position will be responsible for the technical oversight of staff and consultants performing design, surveying, and testing of materials and construction of Airport projects.

Position Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering
- Current and valid registration as a civil engineer issued by the California State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers, OR, the ability to obtain such registration within 6 months of employment.
- 10 years full-time experience performing duties which include difficult and complex civil engineering projects with at least 7 years working on airport projects.
- 5 years of management experience with direct supervisory responsibilities for difficult and complex civil engineering projects for public works projects

Notes:

Compensation is 180K per year. Total Rewards include: health benefits, life insurance, 401K, PTO and 9/80 work schedule. Relocation reimbursement is available up to 10K for household moves greater than 200 miles.

TBI is the private operator of the Hollywood Burbank Airport administrative and operational staff.

Hollywood Burbank Airport (BUR) is a public airport three miles northwest of downtown Burbank, in Los Angeles County, California. Located on 550 acres, BUR is the closest L.A.-area Airport to the majority of L.A.'s most popular destinations. The Airport is owned by the Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority, controlled by the governments of those cities. The Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority is a separate government agency created under a joint powers agreement between the three cities of Burbank, Glendale, and Pasadena in 1977 for the sole purpose of owning and operating the Hollywood Burbank Airport.
