With the passage of Measure B by Burbank voters on November 8, 2016, Hollywood Burbank Airport is working with the community and neighboring cities to build a safer, 14-gate replacement passenger terminal that is farther from the runways and meets current earthquake design standards. The replacement passenger terminal will provide the same convenience and easy access that air travelers now enjoy while providing greater user amenities.
